- AP African American Studies Exam Pilot: For the 2024 AP Exam administration, only schools that are participating in the 2023-24 AP African American Studies Exam Pilot can order and administer the exam.
- Schools must begin the morning exam administration between 8 and 9 a.m. local time and the afternoon exam administration between 12 and 1 p.m. local time. The AP Physics C: Electricity and Magnetism Exam must begin between 2 and 3 p.m. local time. Schools in Alaska must begin the morning exam administration between 7 and 8 a.m. local time and the afternoon exam administration between 11 a.m. and 12 p.m. local time. The AP Physics C: Electricity and Magnetism Exam in Alaska must begin between 1 and 2 p.m. local time.
- AP coordinators are responsible for notifying students when and where to report for the exams. Early testing or testing at times other than
  those published by College Board is not permitted under any circumstances.
- AP coordinators should order late-testing exams for students who would like to take exams that are scheduled for the same time.
- AP Seminar and AP Research students must submit final performance tasks and their presentations must be scored by their AP Seminar or AP Research teachers by 11:59 p.m. ET on April 30, 2024.
- On their AP Digital Portfolio, students participating in AP Computer Science Principles must submit their Create performance task as final by 11:59 p.m. ET on April 30, 2024.





## E-Summer Program @ NOVA



NOVA is currently accepting applications for its **E-Summer Program @ NOVA!** 

The E-Summer Program at NOVA is sponsored by the <u>Hispanic Association of Colleges & Universities (HACU)</u> and <u>Dominion Energy</u>. This program is designed to introduce students to STEM and the energy industry and is targeted to Hispanic and underrepresented minority students! Rising juniors and seniors that meet <u>qualifying GPA or test score requirements</u> may apply. Students will be offered two courses at no cost: <u>CSC 221: Introduction to Problem Solving and Programming (3cr)</u> and <u>SDV 100: College Success Skills (1cr)</u>, earning four college credits over the six-week program. Students must take both courses.

The program will be held at NOVA's Alexandria, Manassas, and Woodbridge Campus over six weeks, starting July 1. Students must select their preferred campus. Classes will be in a hybrid format — on-campus on Mondays and Wednesdays from 9am-1:00pm <u>and</u> virtual (via zoom) on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9am-11am. Attendance is mandatory at all in-person and virtual class sessions.

In addition to course content, students will hear from industry speakers to learn more about the energy industry and career opportunities, participate in a field trip to a Dominion Energy Facility, and learn more about NOVA support resources and the benefits of higher education. Lunch will be provided on Mondays and Wednesdays.
