Let's check out what's happening on **TEAM Winderl** in his amazing Computer Application Class!!

Stop-motion animations are used in video class to introduce students to concepts and skills used throughout the year. First, as a team, students brainstorm and choose a theme to be used for their animation. Second, individually, students create a storyboard based on the team theme. Third, as a team, they share their individual storyboards and create a final version of their storyboards. Fourth, as a team, they create a script to go with the storyboard. Fifth, as a team, they design/create the background(s) and characters to be used for the animation. Sixth, as a team, they take pictures of their background(s) and characters. Seventh, individually, they use editing software to turn the pictures into a cohesive animation.

Throughout the project, students learn that the more detailed they are at the front end of the project with planning, the easier it is for them to remain organized throughout the project and create a meaningful animation at the end that makes sense. Furthermore, they use STEAM concepts that aid in the creative process.

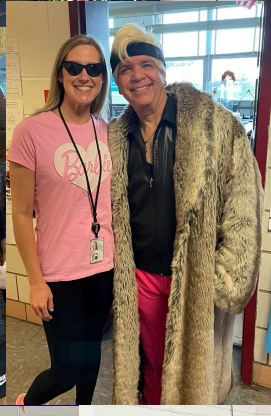

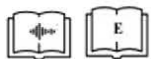
Virginia Readers' Choice

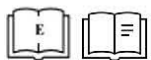

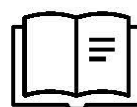
